- Playing within the rules of the game and respecting officials and their decisions.
- Respecting the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of gender, ability, age, cultural background, sexual orientation or religion.
- Arriving promptly at the agreed time for training and matches and informing the team coach/manager if you are going to be absent or late for a match.
- Wearing suitable kit for training and match sessions.
- Paying any fees for membership, training or events promptly.
- Abiding by the rules of any premises or competitions.
- Refraining from the consumption of alcohol or drugs of any kind whilst representing the Club.
